Confession is agreement by a second person with what a prior person said. The Holy Spirit is perfect at letting us know we have sinned and that He is not pleased with it. God told us through John, "If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness"-1 John 1:8-9. If we love Jesus then our "homologeō" will include acknowledgement of sin and repentance from it. We will agree with the reality of what we did and with God's heart regarding it.
