HOME GROUPS: Starting back up again in September! If you have not joined a home group, we encourage you to! There are sign up sheets at the front desk if you don't have a group.

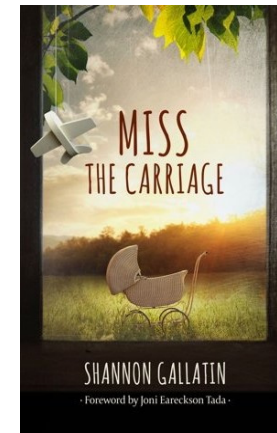
