Classes begin January 5th & end April 15th

The Rapture Question: This course taught by Pastor Scott Hathorn will be a detailed study of the various positions concerning the rapture. Join Pastor Scott Mondays from 1:00-3:00.

NT 360 Hebrews: Pastor Bil Gallatin will teach this course on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings from 9:30-11:30. Pastor Bil is a gifted expositor and will take the student line upon line through Hebrews with an in-depth look at how we as believers may live in the Holiest of All fellowshiping with God continually. This course will be for the first part of the semester.

NT 330 Acts: This is a verse by verse study of the book of Acts. Taught by Pastor Bil Gallatin the student studies the Church, the work of God the Holy Spirit, and how He through the Church has changed the world. Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday mornings from 9:30-11:30. This course will begin when Pastor Bil completes Hebrews.

Apologetics: Taught by Pastor Ray Viola this course will look at some of the major cults and how to answer questions concerning them. This course will be Tuesday from 1:30-3:30.

OT 320 Psalms: This course is a survey study of the book of Psalms discussing the various types of Psalms such as thanksgiving psalms, messianic psalms, etc. Taught by Pastor Tony on Wednesdays from 12:30 – 3:00 and Fridays from 9:30-11:30.

M 380 Ministry of Prayer: This course answers questions, “What is prayer”, “What is the purpose of prayer”, and “How do we learn to pray”. Taught by Pastor Ted Meilleur on Thursday from 1:30- 3:30.

Community Outreach: Each Friday students reach out in various areas of the community. Nursing homes, Fathers Heart Ministry, even doing projects at homes. Join us from 12:00-5:00 each Friday.
